- What are the key features of a dairy farm?

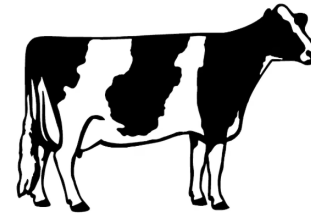
**In maths we will be focusing on:**
