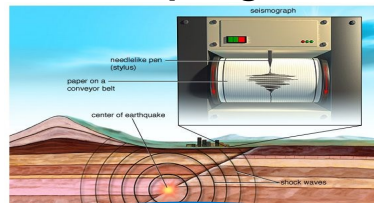

Our enquiry is:

In Music we will be focussing on:
