In English we will be focussing on:

Writing to entertain—traditional tales.

We will be using the fairy tale of the Princess and the Pea to guide an independent write based on a continuation of the story in a fairy tale style of writing.

 Chronological Report— Sutton Hoo Discovery.

We will be writing a report on the discovery of the Anglo-Saxon Burial at Sutton Hoo.



In maths we will be focussing on:

- Fractions Hundredth will be introduced for the first time and equivalent and simplifying fractions will also be explored.
- Decimals— Writing, comparing, adding and subtracting decimals and understanding their place value.



In RE we will be focussing on:

Salvation—Why do Christians call the day
Jesus died 'Good Friday'? We will be investigating the Easter story and the sacrifice Jesus
made for Christians.

Our enquiry is:

In Music we will be focussing on:

 Play and perform in ensemble context, using their voices and playing musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression.

- How and why did the Anglo-Saxons become Christians?
