Year 4: Charlie

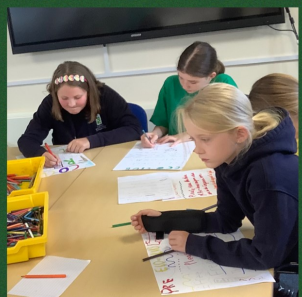
