We have been watching the hardworking parents darting in and out with insects to feed their babies. It has been a wonderful real-life science lesson for the children. We are all eagerly waiting for the moment they are strong enough to take their first flight and fledge into the school grounds!

Yesterday we rescued a vulnerable baby hedgehog, or 'hoglet', that was in Riley's garden. Spotting a hedgehog out during the day is often a sign they are in distress, especially when they are small. Following advice from Paula's Wildlife Rescue, Mrs Henman carefully used gardening gloves to scoop the little one into a high-sided box to keep it safe and calm. It is now receiving specialist care and plenty of food until it is strong enough to be released back into the wild.
